SUBJECT: DUAL ENROLLMENT

I. POLICY

High school seniors who meet prescribed requirements will have high school graduation waived as an admission criteria for *general studies* student status or active status in a non-credit program in order to enroll in CCHS courses while enrolled in high school.

II. PROCEDURE

A. High school seniors who meet the following criteria will be granted a waiver of high school graduation as an admission criterion for *general studies* student status or active status in a non-credit program:

- Rising senior or a senior in high school.
- A 3.0 or better cumulative high school GPA or an SAT score of at least 1000 for *general studies*, or a 2.0 GPA for non-credit program.
- Written support (CCHS Waiver Form is acceptable) from high school guidance counselor or principal, and earn a grade of "C" or better in each CCHS class in order to take additional class(es).

B. All other course prerequisites and admission policies/procedures apply.

C. The Dual Enrollment policy and procedure will be reviewed bi-annually.
