**SUBJECT:** TUITION

**REVIEWER(S):** Board of Directors

**I. POLICY**

The board of directors will approve tuition to assist in offsetting expenses related to the development and delivery of academic programs and administrative and student services. The setting of appropriate tuition will be informed by knowledge of:

1. Operating costs of the college.
2. Strategic college priorities.
3. Tuition and fees at similar institutions.
4. Federal, state, and institutional aid available to students.
5. Other revenue resources available to the college.

Tuition will not be changed without the expressed consent of the board. Recommendations for changes in tuition will be brought before the board, generally at a regularly scheduled meeting, by the college president (or designee). Relevant information, such as points 1 – 5, above, will accompany the recommendation.

Recommendations for changes to fees do not require the board’s approval, though changes in fees may be presented to the board for discussion and support.
