



Procedure to play a Kahoot game:

1. Preview your game before sharing it in class.
 - *Tip #6: Kahoot is delivered completely online. Prepare your students ahead of schedule to have a smart device powered up and online. They may use the school free Wifi.*
2. Decide if you will have individuals play or create teams.
 - *Tip #7: Anticipate that not all students will have a smart device handy. Allowing small teams of 2 -3 creates inclusion of all students, makes peer learning fun and information stick.*
3. On the day of the game, sign in to your Kahoot account.
4. Locate and select **My Kahoots**, found at the top left of the screen.
5. Locate the Kahoot game title and click its **Play** button.
6. Scroll down the new page and select your preferred game options.
 - *Tip #8: Understand the details of the game options before choosing them:*

7. Choose the game mode **Classic** or **Team Mode**
8. Inform each student or team that they will access the game via www.kahoot.it and follow prompts to enter game code and add their name.
 - *Tip #9: Each game elicits a new game code. You can play the game over and over and the code will change each time.*
9. Once everyone is listed on the screen, you click **Start**.
10. Whichever comes first, the last student choosing their answer or the time runs out, the question will tally results.
 - *Tip #10: Use this opportunity to discuss the question and results with your students.*
11. Click the **Next** button when you're ready to move on to the next question.
12. After the last question, ask the students to complete the feedback on their phones. It immediately populates their impressions of this Kahoot in your data.
 - *Tip #11: Save and download the Results at the end of the Kahoot. Use this data to help edit this game, future games, and assess student comprehension of a particular topic. If you miss the opportunity to download at the end of the game, you can "View all of your results" from your Kahoot Account page.*
